## BRAT POUR

Our monthly focus on a single producer's wine.

Ten years ago, Marco Pelletier - (ex head sommelier at Hotel Le Bristol in Paris), chose a miniscule parcel of land to make “Vin de Jardin” or “Wine from the Garden.” This is a minimal intervention, terroir-focused wine that is a response to the “garage wines” trend of over extraction and excessive oak, made popular in Saint-Emilion throughout the 1990s. For Marco and his partners, wine is a beverage that is produced outside, not in a garage. And since their vineyard is less than one hectare in size, it's more of a garden anyway. The wine shows the quintessential, dark chocolate, graphite, and wild herbs that makes Bordeaux so distinct, but with vivid floral notes and ripe, pristine fruit. Galouchey is a real hidden gem that exemplifies everything that's to be lauded and respected about the small grower-producer, and one of the most exciting Bordeaux's in this price range.

# SHERRY

While sherry is often ignored by the larger wine-drinking populace, even an entry-level fino from a great producer shows an astoundingly nuanced and complex character. In today's market where many of the world's finest wines have become prohibitively expensive, sherry still represents one of the wine world's great bargains, as well as being one of the most versatile wines when it comes to food.

## UNDER THE FLOR

Flor is the mysterious layer of yeast that lies on top of some sherry wine while they age in barrel, Fino and Manzanilla spend their entire maturation under flor, whereas Amontillado and Palo Cortado begin their lives under flor being exposed to oxygen once it breaks. These differences make for a diverse and delicious range of sherry styles. The flavours imparted are unlike anything else in the wine world, saline in character with notes of seaspray, almonds and mediterranean herbs.

Sherries that are aged with gentle and controlled exposure to oxygen in the absence of flor are typically richer in texture displaying flavours of walnuts, leather, bitter chocolate and exotic spices.
